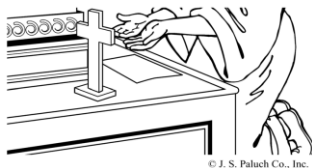

Recognizing Jesus - Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults

Demonic possessions don't seem like a good place to start looking for proof of Jesus' claim to be the Son of God. Setting aside the debate of what possession is, an evil force opposed to the work of God does not seem likely to want to point out the significance of Jesus to a crowd.

Yet in this week's gospel that is exactly what happened. The good, faithful religious people attending synagogue are astonished at the power and authority of Jesus. The demons, however, know exactly who Jesus is and it fills them with fear. In Christ we find the ultimate and final victory over the things in the world that would oppress human flourishing. But too often we humans would rather close our eyes to the truth of Jesus and close our hearts to the possibility of his forgiveness and freedom.

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is a process meant to help us recognize Jesus in our midst and to come to know his meaning for our lives through Baptism and Confirmation as Catholic Christians. Dayspring Monthly Birthday Party

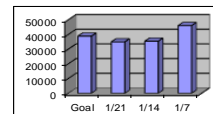
