One Heart and Mind – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults



The first Christian community in Jerusalem was tiny, but transformed. The first reading today tells us that they shared everything, including their money, in common, and that the apostles preached with great power. It says this fledgling church was “of one heart and mind (Acts 4:32).” In light of the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead, these men and women could not live in the same way. Their lives were radically different and they were marked, above all, by their unity with each other and with the apostles. This apostolic unity of Christ’s church has continued throughout the ages through the line of the bishops in the Catholic Church.

We are invited today into that same joy and radical freedom from our old lives which weigh us down in sin, addiction, anger, or even boredom. Our lives can be radically different and – although we do not have to share every single thing we own – we are invited into that same unity with other Christians.

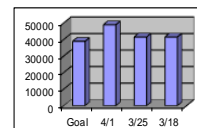
