## From the Desk of Fr. Dan

### Rediscover Jesus

Each week we will be reading four chapters, this week the Prologue to chapter 4. Our questions for discussion are below. Remember that the discussion can take place anywhere, the kitchen table with your family, the coffee table with your friends, any place is fine. Our goal is to just talk about Jesus some this summer and get to know him better. Thanks for being part of the Holy Spirit at Geist summer of 2017 book discussion. Enjoy!

Prologue: Remember the story of the fruit stand. Have you ever seen someone acting like Jesus? How and When? Have you ever done the same?

(1). Do I need to start a new relationship with Jesus, Renew what I have with Jesus or just stay on the course I have with Jesus now? What could change?

(2). Jesus is always there for us, if we but seek Him out. He knows us better than we know ourselves. Are there things we try to hide from Him, like Adam and Eve in the Garden? Who are we kidding?

(3). We are invited to know Jesus better, what do I have to do to open my heart to Him? Do I ever fear what He may ask of me?

(4). Look at the world around us. For 2000 years millions of people have followed Him, some have given their lives in martyrdom, others have lived for Him, some lived with Him and some lived around Him. Where am I living, for Him, with Him, around Him? And where do I want to be living?

Therefore we will be celebrating Mass at Holy Spirit on Monday and Friday at 8:15. The morning Masses on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday will be Communion Services. ### RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) – Summertime

One of the most-often asked questions about RCIA is "when does it begin?" There is no single answer to that question; for some, RCIA "began" years ago when they met a Catholic neighbor while for others, who may only want to ask a few questions about what Catholics believe, RCIA has not yet begun. The more important question might be "when do I begin?" The answer is "Now!"

Summertime is a perfect time to begin RCIA – the groups tend to be smaller so the conversation and questions are more wide-reaching. Inquiry is an open-agenda forum that meets on Monday evenings from 7:00-8:30 pm in the Parish Life Center. While it is a first step in the RCIA, you will never be pressured to become Catholic. If you've been part of Holy Spirit for years without having "officially" become Catholic, we want to meet you too as there is no one-size-fits-all in RCIA.

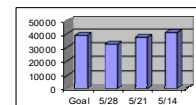
