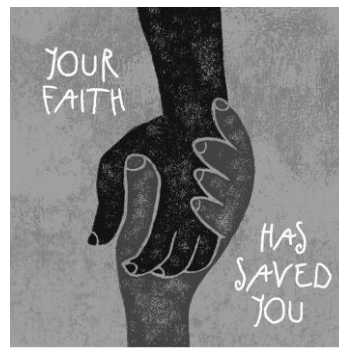

Healed and Whole

Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults



Two women – one young and full of promise, one old and worn down from a lifelong illness – are healed by Jesus of Nazareth in today's gospel. The older was bleeding for twelve years, as long as the young girl had been alive. She was outcast from society and was forbidden from touching anyone lest she make them ritually unclean. She dares to touch Jesus in a crowd hoping no one will notice because everyone is pressing around him. Instead he stops and seeks her out in order to praise her faith.

But healing that woman prevents Jesus from making it to Jairus' house in time to save Jairus' young daughter from death. Jesus had agreed to go to her and he failed. His compassion seems to have gotten in the way... Until, we realize, even death is not an obstacle for this man. He makes both women whole and pushes back the tide of disease and emptiness a little more. The kingdom of God is gaining ground.

Everyone yearns to be whole and free from the fear of the world's darkest parts. God wants to turn the tide in our own lives and our own time, just as Jesus did when he walked the roads in Galilee. God wants us to dare to reach for him, to dare to believe that death does not have the final say. That daring is the work of the Holy Spirit within us, the same Holy Spirit God pours into every Christian. We invite you to come and learn how God can make you healed and whole through the baptism and confirmation as a Catholic Christian at Summer Inquiry for the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults).
