## Called to Transform the World

*Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults*



Jesus offers every person a chance to be part of building the kingdom of God. It is not just for priests or nuns or monks to do God's work. Being baptized as a Catholic Christian means being called to bring the presence of God into reality in the lives of those around us. Us regular folks – the Laity – are absolutely necessary to God's mission of love.

The Church puts it this way in its apostolic constitution *Lumen Gentium*:

“[Lay people] carry out for their own part the mission of the whole Christian people in the Church and in the world...”

By their very vocation, [lay people] seek the kingdom of God by engaging in temporal affairs... by ordering them according to the plan of God. They live in the world, that is, in each and in all of the secular professions and occupations. They live in the ordinary circumstances of family and social life, from which the very web of their existence is woven. They are called there by God... and led by the spirit of the Gospel they may work for the sanctification of the world from within as a leaven. In this way they may make Christ known to others, especially by the testimony of a life resplendent in faith, hope and charity (*Lumen Gentium*, 31).”

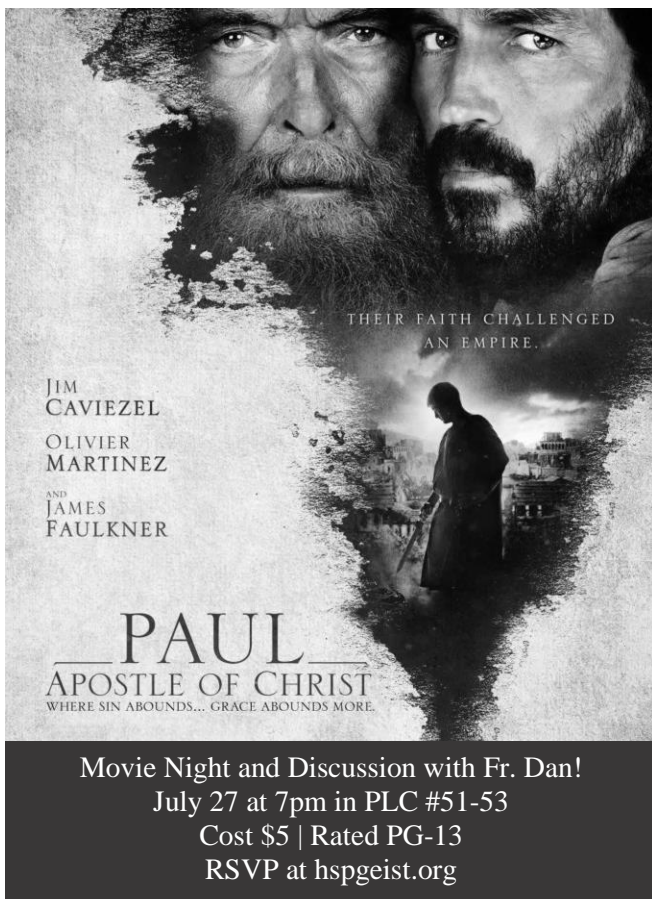
