Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults

“Be a good person. Treat others with respect.

Be kind.” Every culture, profession, and community has a set of ethical and moral norms to which they adhere. Professionally, ethics are important as well, with many people holding themselves to high standards of behavior because they believe it is good and right. This is the type of person we see in the rich young man in today’s gospel. Because the young man loves God, he is a good, ethical person who follows the commandments. And for this, Jesus looks at him and loves him. This man is a good person. Yet to inherit the kingdom of God, Jesus asks him to sell everything and follow. He has to respond to his encounter with Jesus by stepping beyond ethics into the realm of self-gift. It is not enough to be a good person alone. We must offer our whole lives and everything we have to follow Jesus.

Baptism is the sacramental sign of that total commitment and the way God brings us into God’s own life. Confirmation seals that self-gift with the gift of the Holy Spirit.
